Parade Rules and Regulations The Following Rules and Regulations are Mandatory

The MCVA reserves the right to reject or dismiss any entry, which violates the below stated Rules and Regulation. Furthermore, the MCVA reserves the right to deny participation in Further Parades by groups/bands ignoring and/or violating these Parade Rules and Regulations.

Throwing of Candy And/Or Handouts: Throwing of Candy and/or handouts
will not be permitted. They can be handed out.

ALCOHOL: The Consumption of Alcohol Is Strictly Prohibited During The Parade And Its Staging Area.

ENTRY: Only Those entries registered and having paid the appropriate entry fee will gain access to the Parade. Any entry bringing excess vehicles not approved by the committee will be denied participation. The letter of acceptance issued by MCVA must be presented the day of the Parade or the unit will be turned away. Initial:

NOISE: All units will be required to keep the blowing of horns, sirens, and whistles at a minimal volume throughout the Parade route. Top quality bands have been contracted at considerable expanse, and are placed throughout the Parade so as not to compete with each other or loud and distracting noises. All entries must indicate if they have music or sound amplifying systems, and shall maintain a volume that will not interfere with other entries, especially those with animals. If a unit is informed by the Parade marshal(s) or the police that the noise generated by their unit is too loud, they shall immediately turn the volume down or take other steps identified by the Parade marshal or the police.

FLOW OF THE LINE OF MARCH: Keep up with the unit in front of you at all times, with NO STOPS FOR PERFORMANCES ALONG THE ROUTE. Our goal is to get the entire Parade out on the track in 30-40 minutes. Your cooperation will help. The Parade line-up is based on proper flow and movement of the Parade, staging space and safety. Initial: **SAFETY:** Entries with children under the age of 18 must also have parents or other adult chaperones riding and/or walking alongside, who provide supervision. Applicants are required to ensure the safety of persons riding on the floats. Persons riding on floats or flatbeds trucks must be seated if there are no protective restraints. The MCVA and town of Stroudsburg/E. Stroudsburg are not responsible for the safety of the float or the person riding the float. The applicant is required to comply with all applicable laws to ensure everyone's safety. Participants on bicycles, scooters, skates, segways, skateboards, etc. must wear a helmet and proper safety equipment. Initial:_____ **ANIMALS:** Animals participating in the parade must be kept under control. If you cannot control you animal or its presence presents any safety issue, please leave the parade area with your animal rather than risk a problem. Entries involving animals of any kind must provide their own clean up, or "pooper scooper", immediately following their entry. Initial: **Late Arrivals:** Those arriving late will be placed at the end of the Parade. Initial:_____

Right of refusal: The parade committee reserves the right of refusal to any entry deemed offensive to the spirit of the veterans day parade, the general public, or the military branch of services. No offensive language, slogans on clothing or offensive clothing in general will be allowed. The spirit of the parade is centered on the veterans and the men and women who are serving now in our armed forces. It is not to be used as a vehicle for political, social, or ideological venues. All applicants will be subject to review by the MCVA board.
