(Exit 302 from I-80 W or 302B from I-80 E)

- *Travel north on Route 611, 1/2 mile to the second traffic light
- *Turn left onto Rimrock Drive
- *Follow Rimrock Dr. for 0.4 mile
- *Bear right onto N. Easton-Belmont Pike
- *Travel .2 miles
- *Bear right onto Running Valley Road
- *The Center is 0.7 mile on the left.
