

## HUNTING LICENSE

Monroe County Treasurer, Theresa Johnson is informing you the **2020-2021 regular hunting license will be available June 22, 2020 On-Line and at available Issuing Agents.** Monday thru Friday 8:30am – 4:30pm at the Treasurer’s Office in room 103 of the Monroe County Administrative Building at 1 Quaker Plaza in Stroudsburg. **FREE HUNTING DIGESTS WILL BE AVAILABLE**

We have included a PA State WMU Map below to help prepare for Antlerless Season as well as the Application Mailing Schedule.

### ANTLERLESS DEER LICENSE INSTRUCTION

All doe license applications **MUST** be mailed in a (**PINK**) official antlerless deer license envelope directly to a County Treasurer. You may send your application to **ANY** County Treasurer, not just one located within your Wildlife Management Unit (WMU) preference. **DO NOT** mail application to Game Commission.

At least one WMU preference must be entered on the application. If you are applying with others, limit of three individual applications per envelope for the exact same WMU preferences, submit (**ONE**) check or money order for all three applications. If applicants select different WMU, a separate check or money order for each application is strongly recommended. Otherwise, all applications could be rejected if one cannot be processed due to a selected WMU selling out.

Write your CID number on your check or money order must be U.S. Dollars and payable to County Treasurer. Please print plainly and sign and date your application.

### 2020 ANTLERLESS DEER LICENSE APPLICATION SCHEDULE


- JULY 13** First day resident antlerless deer license applications accepted by County Treasurer via U.S. Postal Service (**MAIL ONLY**).
- JULY 20** First day nonresident’s antlerless applications accepted by County Treasurer via U.S. Postal Service (**MAIL ONLY**).
- AUGUST 3** If antlerless deer licenses are still available, County Treasurers accept antlerless deer license applications from residents and nonresidents for unsold tags **WMU’s, 2B, 5C, and 5D** applicants **may apply for unlimited number of unsold tags** by County Treasurer via U.S. Postal Service (**MAIL ONLY**), limit 3 applications per envelope.
- AUGUST 17** If antlerless deer licenses are still available, County Treasurers accept antlerless deer license applications from resident and nonresidents for a **second unsold tag** by County Treasurer via U.S. Postal Service (**MAIL ONLY**).

**AUGUST 24**  
**Over the counter sales begin unlimited in 2B, 5C, and 5D.**

**SEPTEMBER 14**  
Regular and first round unsold license are scheduled to be mailed.

**SEPTEMBER 28**  
Second round unsold license are scheduled to be mailed.

**OCTOBER 5**  
If antlerless deer license are still available and the applicant has not exceeded his/her limit County Treasurers can accept antlerless applications over the counter.
