Our senior centers are a vital part of our community. In the 2024/2025 fiscal year alone, we served nearly 6,400 meals and fed nearly 300 regular attendees. The centers have even more to offer than meals and bingo, though—they are places where seniors can learn to live healthy, active lives, socialize, and maybe even find some extra purpose. They are the hub of our health and wellness evidence-based programs.

Throughout Pennsylvania, senior centers have been closing or are at risk of closing due to a lack of funding. We are so fortunate in Monroe County to still have all of ours open. We oversee four and have a fifth in cooperation with the Jewish Resource Center (see Page 10 for their offerings).

We are excited to announce that Barbara Schlegel is the new manager at the Mountain Senior Center! Many of you know her from her involvement in MSVP and her participation in our events and classes. Welcome, Barbara! We are excited to have you on our team!

On Page 4, you will find our centers' activity plans for September, and on Page 6, we have our schedule of health and wellness programs. Zumba® Gold—Seated is being offered at four of our centers in September. A class on Medicare Fraud Prevention will be held at the Chestnuthill and Mountain centers (see Page 3).

Medicare Annual Open Enrollment October 15th – December 7th

The Medicare Annual Open Enrollment Period will be from October 15th to December 7th. During this period each year, Medicare beneficiaries can join, switch, or drop their Medicare Part D or Medicare Advantage coverage.

The coverage and costs for Medicare Part D and Medicare Advantage plans change each year, so it is important to review your plan and compare it to others on the market that are available to Monroe County residents.

Pennsylvania Medicare Education and Decision Insight (PA MEDI), a health counseling insurance program Medicare beneficiaries residing will Pennsylvania, have counselors available during the entire Annual Open Enrollment Period. These unbiased and friendly counselors will help understand your options in comparing Part D and Medicare Advantage plans at the following locations in the community: Loder Senior Center in East Stroudsburg, Mountain Senior Center in Tobyhanna, Senior Barrett Center in Cresco. Chestnuthill Senior Center Brodheadsville, and the Middle Smithfield Township building in East Stroudsburg.

Our PA MEDI counselors are volunteers from the Monroe Senior Volunteer Program (MSVP). They work hard to learn everything they can to provide the best assistance.

This counseling is free. To schedule an appointment, please call the Monroe County Area Agency on Aging at 570-420-3735 (Appointments for the Annual Open Enrollment will be taken beginning September 15th.) Call to reserve your appointment early. Appointments will likely be full by October 15th.



Have you picked up your farmers market vouchers?

If you have not yet applied for the Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP), there is still time! The last day to apply and pick up vouchers will be September 30th.

The SFMNP provides \$25.00 in vouchers to eligible seniors to be redeemed at farmers markets throughout the county. To be eligible for the program, older adults must be 60 years of age or older (or turn 60 by 12/31/2025), reside in Monroe County, and have a gross income at or below \$28,953 for a single individual and \$39,128 for a married couple.

The Loder Center (62 Analomink Street, 2nd Floor, in East Stroudsburg) will continue to accept applications and give out vouchers until September 30th on Tuesdays from 10am to 12pm and on Wednesdays from 1pm to 3pm. We do not accept mailed applications.

If you are unable to go yourself, you can send somebody in your place with a proxy form signed by you and the person who will be picking up your vouchers. Proxy forms are available online, at the Aging Office, and at the Loder Center.

If you have vouchers already, please be sure to <u>REDEEM THEM</u> this season so we can receive them again next year! Contact MCTA if you need a ride to a farmers market: (570) 839-8210.

AARP Driver Safety Class in the Fall

AARP's Smart Driver course will take place this fall at the Monroe County Emergency Management building, 100 Gypsum Road, Stroudsburg, PA 18360.

If you do not currently have an AARP driver safety certificate, you must take the two-part eight-hour course on October 28th & 29th from 12pm to 4pm each day. Please arrive at least 15 minutes before the class start time to complete course paperwork and to obtain course materials. Course cost is \$20 for AARP members and \$25 for non-members. Cash, check, and money orders will be accepted (checks and money orders payable to "AARP"). Individuals that have AARP UnitedHealthcare Medicare Supplement Insurance plans may be eligible to take the course at no cost through their insurance.

Bring your driver's license and valid AARP membership card or number if you are a member.

For those who possess the certificate, the refresher course is October 30th from 12pm-4pm. Once the course has been completed, the certification is valid for three years, and you may

qualify for a 5% discount on your auto insurance.

Advance registration is required for both classes, and seating is limited.

Property Tax / Rent Rebate Deadline Extended

Homeowners, renters, and some residents of personal care / nursing homes may be eligible for a rebate of up to \$1,000 on their paid taxes or rent. Applicants must be 65 or older, widows/widowers 50 or older, or 18 or older with a disability. The money issued is based on the applicant's annual income, which must have been \$46,520 or less in 2024:

Income	Maximum Rebate
\$0 - \$8,270	\$1,000
\$8,271 - \$15,510	\$770
\$15,511 - \$18,610	\$460
\$18,611 - \$46,520	\$380

Assessors will wear Monroe County polos and official photo ID badges. If any individual claims to be a field assessor and attempts to enter a residence, contact local law enforcement immediately. Suspicious activity can also be reported to the Monroe County Assessment Office at (570) 517-3133.

Beware of Aging Office Impersonators

Recently, Pike County Area Agency on Aging was notified that a local senior received a phone call from a scammer impersonating an Aging staff member. The caller attempted to sign the senior up for an Emergency Response Button and requested their banking information. Please remember we would never call and ask for bank account information. Only those participating in consumer reimbursement programs with us would ever be asked to provide specific account information. Also, when an Aging staff member visits your home, ask to see an ID badge to confirm they work for the county.

Susan enjoys reading, traveling, cooking, and taking care of her cat, Ellie.






